driving directions

Directions to Campus:

. From north of Charlotte via I-85

Take exit 45A (Harris Blvd). Merge onto Harris, go 1 mile to the exit for UNC Charlotte/Hwy 49. At bottom of exit ramp, turn left on 49; campus is 1 mile on left.

. From north of Charlotte via I-77

Take exit 18 (Harris Blvd). Turn left onto Harris and go 7 miles to the exit for UNC Charlotte/Hwy 49. At bottom of exit ramp, turn left on 49; campus is 1 mile on left.

. From south of Charlotte via I-85

Take exit 45A (Harris Blvd). Turn right onto Harris and go one mile to the exit for UNC Charlotte\Hwy 49. At bottom of exit ramp, turn left on 49; campus is 1 mile on left.

- From south of Charlotte via I-77: Take I-77N to I-85N and follow above directions via I-85.
- From east of Charlotte via US 74: Turn right onto Harris Blvd, and travel 9 miles to UNC Charlotte \Hwy 49 exit. At bottom of exit ramp, turn left on 49; campus is 1 mile on left.
- From Concord area via US 29: Turn left onto Harris Blvd and go 1/2 mile to UNC Charlotte\Hwy 49 exit. At bottom of exit ramp, turn left on 49; campus is 1 mile on left.
